In the Shorted Nets section it shows customer's CAD netlists that are shorted. The Shorted Nets are displayed with the same Item number in the table.

In the Open Nets section it shows customer's CAD netlists that are open. The individual disconnected Nets are displayed with the same Item number in the table.

TIPS & HINTS

If Data is not properly assigned in the submission process, the Netlist Compare will likely show Opens or Shorts.

Here are some typical issues that you may encounter:

1. If you enter the wrong polarity you can have a lot of shorts or opens.
2. If you set Non-Plated holes as Plated you can have shorts.
3. If you set Plated holes as Non-Plated you can have opens.
4. If your layers are not aligned you can have shorts or opens.
5. If your Drill File is the incorrect format you can have shorts or opens.
